

# Privacy notice

The **Hungarian Catholic Bishops' Conference** (seat: 1071 Budapest, Városligeti fasor 45., tax number: 18181490-1-42, „HCBC”) for complying with the Regulation 679/2016 of the European Parliament and of the Council („**Regulation**”) informs you in this privacy notice on the processing of your image and voice in photos and video recordings taken at religious events:

## 1 Information on data processing

- 1.1. Data processing related to taking photos and video recordings
  - 1.1.1. HCBC processes your image and in case of video recordings your image and voice for the purpose of recording its events and presenting its activities.
  - 1.1.2. The legal basis of data processing is Article 6 Section (1) Point f) of the Regulation (legitimate interest determined on the basis of an interest test) and in respect of the religious data Article 9 Section (2) Point d) of the Regulation. The legitimate interest of HCBC is to perpetuate the events it organizes and leave a memory of them for future generations.
  - 1.1.3. HCBC makes your personal data to the Secretariat of HCBC available.
  - 1.1.4. HCBC does not erase your personal data.
- 1.2. Data processing related to the use of photos and video recordings
  - 1.2.1. HCBC processes your image and in case of video recordings your image and voice for the purpose of the transmission of events to Christ believers.
  - 1.2.2. The legal basis of data processing is Article 6 Section (1) Point f) of the Regulation (legitimate interest determined on the basis of an interest test) and in respect of the religious data Article 9 Section (2) Point d) of the Regulation. The legitimate interest of HCBC is to *proclaim the Gospel also by using its own means of mass communication to all people independently of all human power* and to therewith comply with Can. 747 §1 the Code of Canon Law (Vatican, 1983) as set in the translation published in 2015.
  - 1.2.3. HCBC makes your personal data to the Secretariat of HCBC and to the visitors of the website [katolikus.hu](http://katolikus.hu) available.
  - 1.2.4. HCBC does not erase your personal data.

## 2 Data protection officer, exercising data subjects' rights, possible steps in case of infringement

The data protection officer of HCBC is DataPro Tanácsadó Betéti Társaság (contact detail: [adatvedelem@katolikus.hu](mailto:adatvedelem@katolikus.hu)).

HCBC complies with your request on exercising your data subjects' rights within a maximum of one month from the receipt thereof. The date of receipt of the request does not count for the calculation of the deadline. If necessary, taking into account the complexity of the request and the number of requests, HCBC may extend this deadline by another two months. HCBC notifies you of the extension of the deadline, stating the reasons for the delay, within one month of receiving the request. You may exercise the following rights in connection with the processing of your personal data: right to access, right to restriction of the data processing, right to object and right to erasure. If you believe that HCBC has violated your rights during the processing of your personal data, you may contact the data protection officer of HCBC at the email address [adatvedelem@katolikus.hu](mailto:adatvedelem@katolikus.hu), you may lodge a complaint with the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority (email address: [ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu](mailto:ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu), mailing address: 1363 Budapest, Pf. 9., address: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., phone: +36 (1) 391-1400, website: [naih.hu](http://naih.hu)) or you have the opportunity to go to court to protect your data, which will act in expedited procedure. In this case, you are free to decide whether to bring an action before the regional court having jurisdiction over your place of residence (permanent address) or place of residence (temporary address) or the registered seat of HCBC.
